The Kingston is a three section profiling bed with a high quality beech effect finish, specifically designed to suit the needs of the community environment. With an easy to use patient handset offering a range of electrically adjustable features, including the auto contour function, it ensures all needs with regard to comfort and functionality are met. The simplistic and lightweight design means each individual section of the Kingston bed weighs less than 22 kgs, enabling it to be easily assembled, dismantled and transported by a single person, thus reducing the risk of moving and handling related injuries.
